SQUAW VALLEY SKI TEAM LIABILITY RELEASE

- I UNDERSTAND THAT MY PARTICIPATION AND/OR MY CHILD’S PARTICIPATION IN THE SPORTS OF SKIING, SNOWBOARDING, SUMMER ACTIVITIES, AND OTHER RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES (COLLECTIVELY REFERRED TO AS THE “Sport”) CAN BE DANGEROUS AND INVOLVE THE RISK OF INJURY AND DEATH.** I understand the Sport involves numerous risks including, but not limited to, the risks posed by variations in terrain and snow conditions, surface and subsurface snow conditions, icy or firm snow, unmarked obstacles, thin snow cover, bare spots, bumps, moguls, stumps, forest growth and debris, erosion control devices, rocks, cliffs, steep terrain, deep snow, avalanches and other hazards whether they are obvious or not. I also understand that the Sport involves risks posed by loss of balance, loss of control, falling, sliding, collisions with other participants and collisions with marked or unmarked natural and man-made objects, including trees, rocks, fences, posts, lift towers, snow making equipment, snowmobiles and other vehicles.
- Despite the risks involved in the Sport and as consideration for being allowed to participate in the Sport, **I AGREE TO EXPRESSLY ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH** which might be associated with my and/or my child’s participation in the Sport and use of the facilities at the Ski Area, including, but not limited to, the use of terrain parks, chairlifts and other mountain transportation, rental equipment, instruction, racing, traveling beyond the ski area boundary, bicycling, hiking, climbing in mountainous terrain, tennis, Frisbee golf, use of the lagoon/pool/spa, zip line, and participation in photo shoots or special events (hereafter collectively referred to as “use of the facilities”).
- I AGREE NEVER TO SUE AND TO RELEASE FROM LIABILITY** Squaw Valley Resort, LLC, Squaw Valley Real Estate, LLC, KSL Capital Partners II, Alpine Sierra Ventures, LLC, JMA Ventures, LLC, Alpine Meadows Ski Resort, LLC, Squaw Valley Ski Holdings, LLC, The Squaw Valley Development Company, Squaw Valley Ski Corporation, Squaw Valley Preserve, Inc., Squaw Valley Hospitality, Inc., Squaw Creek Associates, LLC, the United States of America, Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, and their owners, investors, members, managers, directors, employees, agents, landowners, subsidiaries, and affiliated companies (referred to as “Squaw Valley” and “Alpine Meadows”, respectively, or collectively as the “Ski Area”) for any damage, injury or death to me and/or my child arising from participation in the Sport or use of the facilities of the Ski Area, regardless of cause, including the **ALLEGED NEGLIGENCE** of Squaw Valley and/or Alpine Meadows.
- I understand that this **RELEASE OF LIABILITY** will prevent me, my child, and my heirs from filing suit or making any claim for damages in the event of injury or death arising from my participation or my child’s participation in the Sport or use of the facilities. **I UNDERSTAND THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREE THAT IT IS VALID FOREVER**, and will apply whenever I or my child participate in the Sport or engage in use of the facilities. I understand and agree that each time I use my Season Pass or anyone for whom I have executed this agreement uses his or her Season Pass, that will constitute a renewal and reaffirmation of my and the user’s acceptance of this agreement. **FURTHER, I UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THAT IF I RENEW OR PURCHASE A SEASON PASS FOR ME OR MY CHILD AT ANY POINT IN THE FUTURE, THIS RELEASE WILL BE VALID AND BINDING UPON ME AND/OR MY CHILD.**
- In the event I file or my child or any legal representative files a claim or a lawsuit arising out of my participation or my child’s or the user’s participation in the Sport or the use of the facilities, **I AGREE TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** Squaw Valley and Alpine Meadows for any damages, attorney’s fees or costs arising out of such a claim or a lawsuit. Additionally, I agree that this release will be admissible into evidence.
- I grant exclusive permission to Squaw Valley, Alpine Meadows and their agents, clients, and assigns to use my name, likeness, and photograph/film for the purpose of publicity, public relations, editorial, or other advertising purposes without compensation and without restriction as to frequency and duration.
- In executing this agreement, I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that I am doing so only for myself and/or on behalf of persons for whom I am the parent or legal guardian. In the event that I execute this Release of Liability on behalf of another person, and in the event that the other person brings a claim against Squaw Valley or Alpine Meadows, I agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless Squaw Valley and/or Alpine Meadows as fully set forth in Paragraph 5 above.
- I agree that this release and the Conditions of Issuance are binding upon me, my child, my heirs, assigns and legal representatives. I acknowledge that this agreement is severable and that if any clause is found to be invalid, the offending clause will be stricken and the balance of the agreement will remain in effect and will be enforceable. I agree that any action arising under this agreement will be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction in the State of California. This agreement will be subject to and interpreted under the laws of the State of California.

THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY – DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY ITS TERMS CONDITIONS OF ISSUANCE AND AGREEMENT FOR SEASON PASSHOLDERS

Your Season Pass (“Pass”) is for your use and enjoyment, but is also a revocable privilege. Listed below are some rules and guidelines we hope will make your experience safer and more enjoyable. This is only a partial list; always use common sense and good judgment.

As a condition of holding this Pass and in return for being permitted to use the facilities of the Ski Area, **I agree for myself and/or my child, to the following:**

- The Pass is non-assignable, non-refundable and cannot be transferred to another person or season. **There are no exceptions.** I understand that use of my Pass by anyone other than me shall constitute fraud and will result in the immediate loss of all lift and skiing/riding/participation privileges without compensation and may result in criminal prosecution.
- I understand my Pass is issued only for the 2011-12 winter season, as long as the lifts are in operation, or until May 31, 2012, whichever comes first. I understand that Squaw Valley and Alpine Meadows cannot guarantee snow conditions or the number of usable days in the season, and that refunds or credits are not available. In the event that I renew my Pass for a subsequent season or seasons (“renewal season”), I understand and agree that this Conditions of Issuance and Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement shall remain in effect for each renewal season.
- I understand and agree that each time I use my Pass or anyone for whom I have executed this agreement uses his or her Pass, that will constitute a renewal and reaffirmation of my and the user’s acceptance of this agreement and the release of liability and indemnity agreement.
- I will keep out of all areas marked “Closed.” If I travel beyond the ski area boundary, I agree to assume all risks associated with backcountry travel, including the risk of avalanches. I understand that I may be charged for any rescue, if available, beyond the boundary.
- I agree to read and follow each and every rule stated in Your Responsibility Code, the Placer County Skier’s Responsibility Code, the Freestyle Terrain Users’ Responsibilities, and sections 602(r) and 653i of the California Penal Code. (See below.)
- In the event my Pass is lost or stolen, I must notify the Special Tickets Office and it may be replaced for a \$50 charge. If I do not have my Pass in my possession for any reason, and I desire to ski/snowboard, I will have to purchase a daily lift ticket at the rate being charged to the general public.
- I understand that Squaw Valley and Alpine Meadows reserve the right to restrict the use of my Pass for any reason or to close the resort, or portions of the resort, for any special function or for any reason whatsoever.
- I agree that attempting to use my Pass on any day or night when it is not valid, as shown on this application, will result in immediate revocation of all Pass privileges without compensation, and will be considered fraud.
- Squaw Valley and Alpine Meadows may amend and modify the terms of the Season Pass Program (“Program”) and eligibility for the Program at any time.
- If the management or ski patrol at Squaw Valley or Alpine Meadows believe that my behavior or conduct is inappropriate or unsafe, I understand they have the right to suspend or revoke my Pass without my having any right of refund or reimbursement.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE:

- Always stay in control and be able to stop or avoid others.
- People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and areas.
- Before using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.

FREESTYLE TERRAIN USERS’ RESPONSIBILITIES:

I understand that if I enter a Freestyle Terrain Park, I should read the sign(s) at the entrance to the park. I must inspect the elements and terrain before I ski or ride over them to evaluate the risks and degree of difficulty before participating. I understand that throughout the day snow conditions and terrain features will change. I am solely responsible for knowing and understanding my ability to encounter all terrain features.

CALIFORNIA PENAL CODE:

The following misdemeanors are punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000:

- Skiing/Riding within or entering a CLOSED area. [PC 602(r)]
- Leaving the accident scene if involved in a collision, except to notify authorities or obtain assistance. [PC 653i]

PERMISSION TO TREAT A MINOR

Race Team staff is not allowed to dispense any medication.: including epi-pens and inhalers. Children must be able to self-administer or medication must be available at TTMG. It is your responsibility to provide medication for pre-existing conditions. I, the undersigned parent/legal guardian of a minor, do hereby authorize and consent to any X-ray examination, MRI examination, anesthetic, medical, or surgical diagnosis rendered under the general or special supervision of any member of the medical staff and emergency room staff licensed under the provisions of the Medicine Practice Act or a dentist licensed under the Dental Practice Act and on the staff of any acute general hospital holding a current license to operate a hospital from the State of California Department of Public Health. It is understood that this authorization is given in advance of any diagnosis, treatment, or hospital care being required but is given to provide authority and power to render care which the aforementioned physician in the exercise of his best judgment may deem advisable. It is understood that effort shall be made to contact the undersigned prior to rendering treatment to the patient but that any of the above treatment will not be withheld if the undersigned cannot be reached. I agree, unless I otherwise request, that this release will remain valid as long as my child attends this Squaw Valley Ski/Snowboard Team.
